



JESUS COLLEGE **WRITING-UP SCHOLARSHIPS 2017-18**

The Governing Body proposes to award a minimum of four Writing-Up Scholarships tenable at this College. Applications will be judged on their academic merit.

Who can apply?

Applications are invited from **present third year on a three year DPhil course graduate members** of the College anticipating going in to an unfunded fourth year **or present fourth years on a four year DPhil course e.g. DTC or CDT course** anticipating going into an unfunded fifth year. It is expected that those who receive this College funding will normally be resident in Oxford and they will not be undertaking outside paid employment (beyond limited University or College teaching duties)

How many Scholarships are there?

There will be a minimum of four writing up scholarships awarded. The number will depend on the quality of the applicants.

How much is a Jesus College Writing-up Scholarship worth?

These Scholarships will be to the value of £1,500 and will be tenable for three months from the start of the relevant writing up term.

How do I apply?

Please send the following details:

- A brief statement of your programme of research
- Details of the funding you have obtained to date
- A statement of why you have not completed within the normal 3 year time frame
- Details of your anticipated completion timetable
- A reference from your supervisor **including your anticipated completion date** (email to carole.thomas@jesus.ox.ac.uk is acceptable)
- Brief details of your future plans following graduation

Applications should be emailed to the Academic Director (academic.director@jesus.ox.ac.uk) or Carole Thomas (carole.thomas@jesus.ox.ac.uk), with the subject header Jesus College Writing Up Scholarships 2016-17. There is no application form.

The closing date is **12 noon on Friday 19 May 2017 (4th week)**. **The deadline will be strictly enforced.** Interviews will be held on the morning of Friday 2 June (6th Week of Trinity Term).
